<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We use the White Rose Scheme to ensure all children are exposed to a mastery curriculum but have tailored when units are taught to match the needs of our children. We teach Geometry, Statistics and Measures a lesson a week to ensure they are consolidated rather than taught at the end of a term.</li> <li>We are subscribed to White Rose which supports the delivery of our curriculum with quality resources.</li> <li>A lesson a week is focussed on key skills to ensure that all children have a secure foundation for their future learning in Maths.</li> <li>Subject leader supports staff with the delivery and assessment of Maths and monitors the delivery and assessment of the subject across the school.</li> <li>Information is shared with parents through the school website on the Maths subject leader page where they can access videos and resources that can help children at home.</li> <li>There is an area on the school website under each class page where staff can share what they have being doing in Maths.</li> </ul>	<p>New students who join our school in KS1 and KS2 sometimes have gaps in their Maths knowledge that impact their future learning.</p>	<p>-These gaps need to be identified early. -Appropriate intervention needs to take place to close these gaps.</p>
	<p>Since our Maths resources are well-used, some are becoming worn and need replacement.</p>	<p>-Take a Maths resource inventory. -Consult teachers to identify a lack of any resources. -Order new resources.</p>
