Our School Uniform



In winter children wear:

- red knitted v-neck jumper/cardigan with school logo.
- white shirt with elasticated or clip on red with grey striped tie. **Nursery and Reception children to wear white polo shirts no tie.**
- grey skirt, pinafore or trousers.
- grey or red socks / tights.
- sensible polished black shoes.

In summer the children wear

- white shirt with elasticated or clip on red with grey striped tie (**Nursery and Reception children to wear white polo shirts no tie**) and grey shorts.
- red and white gingham dress
- white or grey socks
- sensible polished black shoes with the dresses

For P.E all children

School PE t-shirt with logo

Plain black shorts

Plain black jogging bottoms or leggings (No designer brands)

School PE hoody or school jumper/cardigan.

Trainers / PE Pumps for Gymnastics (can go bare foot)

On PE days children should come to school dressed in their PE kit. This allows for them to have more time participating in PE lessons with our trained coaches.

Additionally at KS2

Swimming kit including swimming hat

Please note the following:

Jewellery/Earrings - children should not wear Jewellery to school other than stud earrings which they need to be able to take out their own ear studs for PE or leave them out for PE day.

If you are considering having your child's ears pierced, please have it done at the beginning of the summer holidays so that they have time to settle before coming to school in September.

Sensible shoes – especially because of all the outdoor play activities heels of a reasonable height with straps so that they can play and run safely.

Outdoor coats – the yard is very exposed to the strong winds, children need thick, warm coats in the winter for outdoor play.
