## Policy for School Uniform

Reviewed February 2022

**All pupils attending St James' should wear the following uniform:**

Sensible, plain black footwear, with low heels (no more than 2cm high).

Girls are to wear grey skirts or pinafores

School trousers must be plain grey. Tracksuit bottoms are not suitable.

In summer grey cotton shorts can be worn; not football shorts. The girls may wear red checked gingham dresses.

Plain white polo shirts.

Plain red sweatshirts or cardigans, and the school badge.

Tights and socks should also be white or grey.

Pupils not wearing school uniform will be questioned, and parents contacted.

**PE Kit**

Plain black shorts and red sports top with school badge

Black Trainers or pumps

In cold weather only, plain black track suits or joggers and St James' hoodies or school jumper can be worn.

Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on the required days.

Please name all school uniform and PE kit.

**Jewellery**

No jewellery to be worn in school except small studs in pierced ears.

These must be either removed for PE lessons.

Watches can be worn.

Teachers will confiscate any jewellery pupils bring to school, which will then have to be collected from the office by parents.

**Hair**

Long hair should be tied back for reasons of health and safety for pupils.
