#### 5 key Indicators for Impact Monitoring

##### 1. Engagement 60 Active Minutes

WLSP - 1.5 days / week Coaches engage children in Curriculum and extra-curricular clubs

Bikeability – Y5 completed Level 1 and Level 2 , New this time Y4 completed Level 1 Training 16/17 completed

Playground Leader Training for new cohort- impact PHSEE Leader interaction with others, Active 60 Welfare monitor

Track usage- classes, playtimes Lent Walk

Sports Councillors- Pupil voice – Attended 4 meetings -completed tasks, Tour around Wigan Warriors Facilities (WLSP have a new link with Wigan Warriors)

Swimming Transport to enable Y6 to work to achieve NC Swimming 20/23 children 87% successful with this.

Pathways to G & T West Lancashire County Finals opportunities 4 boys attended-none successful this year 1 Girl chose not to attend due to other footballing commitments

##### 3. Increased staff Confidence

WLSP – CPD for staff and Student Teachers- delivery of sports & physical skills

Linked with WLSP new link with Wigan Warriors- 2xstaff attended Rugby League CPD included transferable skill based activities

Forest School Leader Training- CPD Qualification- enhancing in house OAA curriculum

SEND Wheelpower Course- address needs of physical impaired pupil- links made between Active Blackpool representative to provide future opportunities for able bodied children to experience wheelchair based activity- equitable experience.

#### **4. Broader Range of Sports**

WLSP- Fundamental Movement Skills –Reception& KS1, Games: Striking Fielding ( currently a Lancashire County Cricket Coach working with children summer term) Invasion, Target Games-Dodgeball, Curling, Boccia, Archery, Athletics, Gymnastics, OAA onsite activities.

#### **Curricular & Extra Curricular opportunities**

Wigan Warriors Introduction to Rugby Skills Event- linked to WLSP Partnership

Panathlon Events SEND: Curling, Boccia, Fundamental Skills, Multi-skills, Ten Pin Bowling.

Impact SEND children involved in ‘leading’ some activity in lesson, involving classmates in activity where they have been successful

Archery- Summer term introduction to Y5 & Y6

Boccia & Curling - able bodied and physically impaired children can play along side each other ( purchased curling adapters, grab sticks & boccia kit)

Promote local clubs for alternative sports: e.g Cheerleading

#### **5. Participation Competitive Sports**

WLSP and PE lessons enable Reception to Y6 to take part in intra-competitive activities

SHARES & WLSP events: competitions, events & festivals- through our accessing WSLP & SHARES events can be offered free of charge to pupils.

Competition Calendar for both WSLP & SHARES- opportunities for inter school events across year groups within school.

E.g Dodgeball, Football Boys Y12. Y34, Y56, Girls, Park Runs , Athletics, KS1 Multi-skills, Swimming, Panathlon Competitions, Rugby, This Girl Can – Multi sports event, Quadkids

Funded transport to larger competition events so children can take part- removing barriers to attending events

Promoting minority group: Girls Football, This Girl Can event.
